
Japan's Mitsubishi corporation has made a landmark apology for using US prisoners of war as forced labour during World War Two. It is believed to be the first such apology by a Japanese company.

Taiwan's governing Kuomintang has chosen a woman to be its candidate in January's presidential poll, setting up the first-ever all-female contest between the country's two main parties.

CUBA'S EMBASSY TO RE-OPEN IN WASHINGTON

For the first time in more than five decades, Cuba and the US will have embassies in Washington and Havana. Cuban President Raul Castro said the hugely symbolic step was the start of a long and complex road to normalisation. The US and Cuba have had interest sections under the protection of Switzerland since 1977, but this move makes diplomatic business much easier.



PLASTIC-MADE NATIONAL FLAGS TO BE BANNED SOON

The Indian government is going to issue an order putting a ban on use, sale and purchase of plastic-made national flags in the country. There have been complaints that after Republic Day and Independence Day, flags made of plastic are often found lying on roads and gutters.



AN UNDERWATER TENNIS COURT IN DUBAI

After boasting of a tennis court high up in the air built atop the 1,000-foot-tall Burj al Arab hotel, Dubai has wooed an architect to test the waters for an underwater tennis court. Designed with a massive curved roof, the undersea complex will spread out to hold seven courts. The sports arena will also double up as an aquarium with a rooftop coral reef, which will put on display an abundance of sea life for spectators as well as players. Conceived to create an illusion of a natural atoll, once made, the glass covered court will add up to Dubai's stunning record-breaking shoreline. It is being estimated that the transparent ceiling would require a continuous pane of glass measuring at least 108 feet-wide to accommodate the court and spectators.



INDIAN-ORIGIN STUDENTS HELP U.S. WIN MATH OLYMPIAD AFTER 21 YEARS

Two Indian-origin students have helped the US win the prestigious International Mathematical Olympiad after more than two decades. Shyam Narayanan, 17, and Yang Liu Patil, 18, were part of the six-member US team that won the renowned award after a gap of 21 years. India was ranked 37th in the competition. Yang Liu Patil's mother is from China and father from India. In addition to Patil and Narayanan, three other US team members won gold medals: Ryan Alweiss, Allen Liu, and David Stoner. In the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO) held in Chang Mai, Thailand, the US defeated China by just four points. South Korea took third place. China has won the Olympiad the maximum number of 19 times.

GREEK BANK SHUTDOWN COST ECONOMY 3 BILLION EUROS



Nokia has plans to re-enter the smartphone market. After giving up its entire mobile handset business to Microsoft, the company will consider coming back to the smartphone industry next year through the same brand-licensing manner as it did with its N1 tablet. The company does not plan to do anything before the fourth quarter of 2016, as the contract with Microsoft does not allow them to do so. However, post that, the company will go hunting for a partner who would take care of everything from manufacturing, sales, marketing and customer support as well. Nokia would do is give its brand name to the smartphone and will also give inputs in design and market differentiation.

INDIA TO DEVELOP EARLY EARTHQUAKE WARNING SYSTEM

India is heading 27 nation team in developing a model for early earthquake warning system. With the early warning system, researchers will be able to predict occurrence of an earthquake few seconds before which will give enough time to the people to move to a safer place and escape the wrath of deadly earthquake. In addition to developing a model, India will also launch a satellite dedicated to observe surface displacement related to earthquake by 2019.



CHINA MULLS ALLOWING SECOND CHILD FOR ALL COUPLES

China, the world's most populous country which once strictly followed the one-child norm, is now considering allowing a second child for all couples. China currently has a population of 1.3 billion. India is close behind with a population of 1.2 billion. In China, 29 provinces and municipalities have relaxed the one-child policy to allow couples to have a second baby if either parent is from a single-child family.



INDIA'S ISRO EYEING FOR VENUS

After reaching on Moon and Mars, Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) now planning to reach and explore Venus, also an asteroid nearby. Indian space agency is also planning to give second visit to Mars. India's low-cost Mars Orbiter Mission was praised by many and showed the world what ISRO is capable of. ISRO also won prestigious Space Pioneer Award 2015 for Mangalyaan mission. ISRO launched five British satellites using PSLV-C28 on 10 July this year.




GREEK PARLIAMENT PASSES CRUCIAL REFORMS

Greece's parliament has passed legislation on a second batch of reforms needed to help unlock a huge international bailout for the country's stricken economy. The bill, which includes civil justice reforms, a bank deposit protection scheme and measures to shore up the liquidity of the banks, was backed by more than 200 MPs -- a clear majority -- as voting continued in the 300-seat parliament.



INTERNET USERS IN INDIA TO REACH 503 MILLION



According to a report, Led by a growth of 27.8 per cent annually in mobile users, the internet user base in the country is likely to reach 503 million by 2017. The overall internet user base (wireline and wireless) in the country stood at approximately 350 million as on June 2015 and is estimated to

touch 503 million by 2017. In India more than 50 per cent of internet users are mobile-only internet users.

THE WORLD'S BIGGEST APPLE STORE



Dubai, the land of the largest, the tallest and other record-setting landmarks is adding one more feather to its cap of wonders. United Arab Emirates is all set to welcome the world's biggest Apple store in Dubai. Apple fans in the Middle East can rejoice as the brand's first ever store in the region, outside of Istanbul, is set to be

located at the Mall of the Emirates. Spanning over 50,000-square-foot, the world's largest brick-and-mortar Apple Store will throw its doors in August this year. A second Apple Store is expected to open in Abu Dhabi, at the newly-opened Yas Mall.


Dhyan Chand was offered German citizenship





TECH TALK CHARGE YOUR PHONE WITH A CANDLE



- The developers say it can charge two iPhones using a six hour candle
- It is expected to cost \$65 (£41) and can even be used to make a cup of tea


A device that can charge your mobile phone using the heat produced by a candle has been developed to help keep people connected during blackouts. The Candle Charger uses a thermoelectric generator to convert the heat from a naked flame into around 2.5 Watts of energy. The developers say it can be used to charge portable devices such as mobile phones, cameras and other portable devices through a USB port.

THE NEW HORIZONS

NASA's New Horizons probe has made a historic journey past Pluto. The probe has been travelling to Pluto for the last nine years.

WHAT IS NEW HORIZONS?

New Horizons is the first vessel devoted to studying Pluto's environment. The New Horizons probe cost \$700 million yet, weighing in at 1,000 pounds, is only the size of a grand piano. It has made history by reaching its closest approach to Pluto at 8,150 miles from its surface!



HOW FAR IS PLUTO FROM EARTH?


Pluto is 3.26 billion miles away from Earth and is the only body in our solar system to have not yet been visited by a probe.

WHEN WAS PLUTO OFFICIALLY DISCOVERED?

Pluto was officially discovered in 1930 by American astronomer Clyde Tombaugh, who was using one of the most powerful telescopes at the time at the Lowell Observatory in Arizona, USA.

HOW DID PLUTO GET ITS NAME?

Pluto was named by an 11-year-old schoolgirl from Oxford, England, who liked classical mythology and chose to name it after the ancient god of the underworld.



WHEN WAS PLUTO DOWNGRADED TO A DWARF PLANET?

For more than 70 years Pluto was classed as a planet, until 2006, when the International Astronomical Union down-graded it to a dwarf planet. A dwarf planet orbits the sun just like other planets, but it is smaller. Pluto is so small it cannot clear other objects out of its path.

DID YOU KNOW?

1. Pluto is smaller than Earth's moon but larger than previously thought

Pluto is 1,473 miles in diameter, according to recent measurements obtained from New Horizons, while Earth's moon has a diameter of 2,160 miles. Pluto is 18.5% the size of Earth.

2. Disney's Pluto the dog was named after the former planet

Disney's Pluto the dog debuted in the same year the former planet was discovered, but contrary to popular belief, the dog was named after Pluto the (ex)-planet, not vice versa.



NEW HORIZONS REVEALS MORE MOUNTAINS IN PLUTO'S HEART

The latest images from the New Horizons spacecraft have revealed another range of ice mountains on Pluto. The frozen peaks were found on the lower-left edge of the dwarf world's "heart" and are 1-1.5km-high. They sit between a patch of icy, flat terrain, called Sputnik Planum, which scientists believe is less than 100 million years old, and a dark area dating to billions of years ago.



SPAM EMAIL LEVELS AT 12-YEAR LOW



There have been fewer spam emails than at any time in the past 12 years, according to a security firm.

The fall suggests that cyber-thieves are looking to other ways to make money from people going online.


The security firm said legal action against the criminal networks that pipe spam to

people had helped to cut junk.

However, it said the fall in spam had been offset by a rise in the amount of malware being made.

100 MILLION YEAR OLD FOSSILS FOUND

The discovery of fish fossils estimated to be 100 million years old has excited Australian paleontologists as it has filled missing pieces in their knowledge of the period. The fossils include a huge primitive fish dating back 100 million years.



They include the huge eye-socket of a primitive fish called the cooyoo and the skeletons of 20 to 30 diminutive fishes.

APPLE LAUNCHES NEW IPOD TOUCH



Apple is updating its music player for the first time in nearly three years by giving the flagship iPod touch model a faster processor and better cameras, apart from new colours which also extend to the iPod shuffle and iPod nano. The new iPod touch

also enables Apple Music, a subscription service that offers unlimited playback of millions of songs. Apple Music launched June 30 as music fans increasingly embrace subscriptions over pay-per-song services such as Apple's industry-leading iTunes.

BIONIC EYE IMPLANT WORLD FIRST




Surgeons in Manchester have performed the first bionic eye implant in a patient with the most common cause of sight loss in the developed world. Ray Flynn, 80, has dry age-related macular degeneration which has led to the total loss of his central vision. He is using a retinal implant which converts video

images from a miniature video camera worn on his glasses. He can now make out the direction of white lines on a computer screen using the retinal implant.

YAHOO'S 'SILENT' VIDEO TEXTING APP

The next version of Yahoo Messenger app has been launched in the form of a unique video chat facility that promises to make you "feel like your friends are right there with you". It is a unique form of video texting that combines traditional text messages with video that does not include an audio feed. The app, currently available only in the Hong Kong iTunes App Store, seeks to offer a more natural form of communication where users can see each other's reactions in real-time once they start conversations.
