

UNION BUDGET 2015 TO BE PRESENTED ON FEBRUARY 28



The first part of the session would be between February 23 and March 20 while the second part will be between April 20 and May 8. Experts believe that the date has been chosen with the aim to prevent stock market volatility on the very day. TECH TALK



The Saygus V2 smartphone has the potential to be something exceptionally wonderful. It has magnesium frames and an aluminum rim around the sides. The IPx7 certified smartphone is waterproof and can be submerged in up to 1 metre of water for 30 minutes. It sports a 5 inch display with 'ArcticLink III' sunlight-readable screen. It also has front and back light sensors for screen lighting control. For extra protection, the company has added Corning Gorilla Glass 4. Saygus is based in Salt Lake City, Utah, US and currently has no plans to bring the device to India. The phone could be priced at a close to \$700 (roughly Rs 43,000).



WHAT IS THE UNION BUDGET?

The Union Budget, which is a yearly affair, is a comprehensive display of the Government's finances. It is the most significant economic and financial event in India. The Finance Minister puts down a report that contains Government of India's revenue and expenditure for one fiscal year. The fiscal year runs from April 01 to March 31.

WHO PRESENTS THE BUDGET?

Barring a few exceptions - like elections - Finance Minister presents the annual Union Budget in the Parliament on the last working day of February.

WHO PASSES THE BUDGET?

The budget has to be passed by the Lok Sabha before it can come into effect on April 01.

WHAT IS THE FINANCE BILL?

The government proposals for the levy of new taxes, alterations in the present tax structure or continuance of the current tax structure beyond the period approved by Parliament, are laid down before Parliament in this bill.

WHO APPROVES THE FINANCE BILL?

The Parliament approves the Finance Bill for a period of one year at a time, which becomes the Finance Act.

HOW IS THE BUDGET CLASSIFIED?

Union Budget is classified into Revenue Budget and Capital Budget. Revenue budget includes the government's revenue receipts and expenditure. Capital Budget includes capital receipts and payments of the government. Capital expenditure is the expenditure on development of machinery, equipment, building, health facilities, education etc.

DID YOU KNOW?

- ❖ After a gap of 15 years, the Budget will be presented on a Saturday, on February 28. However, it was in 1999 that the then Finance Minister Yashwant Sinha last presented a Budget on a Saturday.
- ❖ The Budget was first introduced in India on 7th April, 1860 from East-India Company to British Crown.
- ❖ The first Finance Member, who presented the Budget in India, was James Wilson on 7th April, 1860.
- ❖ The word "Interim Budget" was for the first time introduced by R.K. Shanmukham Chetty in his budget speech for 1948-49. From then onwards an interim budget began to mean a budget for a short period.
- ❖ The first Budget of the Republic of India was presented by John Mathai on February 28, 1950.

PLANET WITH RINGS 200 TIMES BIGGER THAN SATURN



Scientists have discovered a planet with a ring around it that is 200 times larger than that of Saturn. The ring system likely contains roughly an Earth's worth of mass in light-obscuring dust particles. The light curve tells astronomers that the diameter of the ring system is nearly 120 million kilometers, more than 200 times as large as the rings of Saturn.

HELICOPTERS AT MARS




A helicopter has been proposed at NASA to behave as a low-flying scout on the red planet as means of determining the course of the rover at a small distance on Mars. The helicopter will be acting as an add on to the mars rovers. Through these add-ons, the rover could travel three times the distance as it covers

already. This will aid the scientists on deciding which sites of Mars should be explored.

MINI BRAIN IN OUR SPINAL CORD

US researchers have discovered a "mini brain" hidden in our spinal cord that helps us remain balanced while maneuvering our way through crowd or walking across an icy parking lot in winter so that we do not slip and fall. Such a task happens unconsciously, thanks to a cluster of neurons in our spinal cord that integrate sensory information and make the necessary adjustments to our muscles.



INVISIBILITY CLOAKS ONE STEP CLOSER TO REALITY

Hao Xin, a professor of electrical and computer engineering at the University of Arizona, has made a discovery with new metamaterials that may pave the way for microscopes with super lenses that see molecular-level details, or shields that conceal military airplanes and even people. Metamaterials are artificial materials engineered to bend electromagnetic, acoustic and other types of waves in ways not possible in nature.

WHATSIM MAKES WHATSAPP FREE WORLDWIDE

The people behind Italy's Zeromobile have launched a new venture called WhatSim that sells a \$11.60 SIM card that lets you chat on WhatsApp for free in 150 countries for a year. It's a free download, and after the first year you pay only 99 cents a year.



SMART MIRRORS



New "smart mirrors" have recently been developed that allows people to virtually try on clothes. Created by MemoMi, the mirror allows people to virtually try on clothes, digitally change the colours of the garments and share their choices with friends via email and social media. The mirrors are equipped with computer processors and shoppers can use them to set up personal shopping accounts. This way, they can access their purchase history and try-on videos from any personal device remotely.

MICROSOFT'S HOLOGRAPHIC GLASSES



Microsoft has unveiled a version called Windows Holographic, along with a headset with glasses called HoloLens that will let users see holograms while tracks a user's voice, motion and surroundings. Microsoft said it's working with NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory at the California Institute of Technology on the holographic technology and the lab will use it for Mars exploration starting in July.

AUDIO CLIPS ON FACEBOOK MESSENGER



Social networking site Facebook has launched a new feature for its messenger app that automatically transcribes any file sent as a voice recording and lets the people send voice clips to each other. To send an audio clip, just tap the microphone icon, record the message and send. The tool listens to the full audio clip and posts a typed version below the audio.
