INDIA TO ASSUME G20 PRESIDENCY IN DECEMBER



India will assume the Presidency of G20 for one year, from December 1, 2022, to November 30, 2023. After taking charge, India is expected to host over 200 G20 meetings across the country. India will host the G20 summit in Delhi on September 9 and 10, 2023. Bangladesh, Egypt, Mauritius, Netherlands, Nigeria, Oman, Singapore, Spain and the UAE will be the “guest countries” at the event. The G20 is composed of most of the world’s largest economies, including both industrialized and developing nations, and accounts for around 80% of gross world product (GWP), 75-80% of international trade, two-thirds of the global population, and roughly half the world’s land area.

TENNIS LEGEND ROGER FEDERER ANNOUNCES RETIREMENT



Roger Federer, former World No. 1, has announced that he will bid farewell to professional tennis after the conclusion of the Laver Cup 2022. In his trophy-laden career, Federer has played more than 1500 matches over 24 years. He

has smashed a plethora of records in men’s singles tennis. He has won 20 Grand Slams and the tennis icon has secured 103 career ATP titles since his debut. Coached by Ivan Ljubicic and Severin Luthi, Federer turned pro in 1998. Federer became the oldest World No. 1 at the age of 36 in 2018.



JULY 2022 WAS ONE OF THE THREE HOTTEST JULYS ON RECORD



Globally, July 2022 was one of three warmest Julys on record, close to 0.7°F 0.4°C above the 1991-2020 reference period. It was only marginally cooler than July 2019 and marginally warmer than July 2016. In general, northern hemisphere land masses predominantly experienced well above-average temperatures,

the data reveals, while much of Australia and central Asia endured below-average temperatures. Worryingly, Antarctic sea ice extent reached its lowest value for July in the 44-year satellite data record, at seven per cent below average, well below the previous record.

with \$273.5 billion net worth. He first overtook Mukesh Ambani as the richest Asian in February, became a centibillionaire in April and surpassed Microsoft Corp.'s Bill Gates as the world's 4th richest person last month.

INDIAN-AMERICAN APPOINTED US' AMBASSADOR TO THE NETHERLANDS

Indian-American political activist Shefali Razdan Duggal has been appointed the US' next Ambassador to the Netherlands. Duggal's nomination was confirmed by the US Senate in a voice vote. Duggal, 50, is a Kashmiri Pandit. She was born in Haridwar and shifted to Pennsylvania, US, with her family when she was two years old.

BANKNOTES WITH THE QUEEN'S FACE ARE WORTH \$95 BILLION

The Bank of England has said that banknotes and coins bearing Queen Elizabeth's face will continue to be accepted as forms of payment and that the formal declaration regarding the country's currency will be made seven days after the Queen's funeral. PARIS TO TURN OFF EIFFEL TOWER LIGHTS EARLY TO SAVE ELECTRICITY

Lights on the Eiffel Tower will be turned off at 11:45 pm instead of 1 am starting from September 23 to save energy amid Europe's energy crisis. Extinguishing the monument's lights early would mean a 4% reduction in its power consumption. Lights at other landmark monuments in Paris will be switched off at 10 pm.

NEW SOLAR SYSTEM THAT COULD BE HOME TO ALIEN LIFE DISCOVERED



A new planetary system with two distant planets orbiting around a small, cool star named LP 890-9 has been discovered. The planets, called LP 890-9b and LP 890-9c, take 2.7 and 8.5 days to complete one revolution around the star, respectively.

The latter is also within the star's "habitable zone", making it neither too hot nor cold for alien life.

CHINA DISCOVERS A NEW MINERAL ON THE MOON

China has discovered a new mineral on the moon that is a phosphate mineral in columnar crystal named Changesite-(Y). The mineral was found among samples China brought back to Earth in 2020. This places the nation as only the third to find a new moon mineral. The US and Russia are the only two other countries that have found a new mineral on the moon.

EUROPE UNVEILS HI-TECH SATELLITE TO GIVE QUICK EXTREME WEATHER WARNINGS



Europe has unveiled the MTG-II satellite designed to give earlier extreme weather warnings. The satellite will be launched by the end of the year on an Ariane 5 rocket. The 3.8-tonne spacecraft will be joined in geostationary orbit by three more MTG-I imaging satellites and two MTG-S "sounding" satellites. It'll start sending images from next year onwards.

A RARE DINOSAUR MUMMY DISCOVERED

Scientists claim they've discovered a rare dinosaur mummy in Canada, said to be one of the most well-preserved dinosaur fossils ever found. The remains of the hadrosaur, a duck-billed, large-bodied, herbivorous dinosaur, included a large portion of its tail and right hind foot. Large parts of its exposed skeleton are covered in fossilised skin, which makes it unique.

The device resembles a motorized scooter and is equipped with in-built sensors as well as a harness that patients can wear around their hips.

DUTCH STUDENTS CREATE 3D-PRINTED EV THAT CAPTURES MORE CARBON THAN IT EMITS



A team of students at Netherlands' Eindhoven University of Technology has created an electric vehicle (EV) which captures more carbon than it emits. Called ZEM (zero emission mobility), it runs on a lithium-ion battery pack and most of its parts are 3D-printed from recycled plastics.

ZEM can capture up to two kg carbon dioxide (CO2) over 20,000 miles of driving.



PT USHA QUEEN OF INDIAN TRACK AND FIELD






