THE YOUNGEST SELF-MADE WOMAN ENTREPRENEUR ON HURUN INDIA RICH LIST

The co-founder of Confluent, a streaming data technology company, Neha Narkhede, at the age of only 37, has made it to the list of India's youngest self-made woman entrepreneur. The 37-year-old is the recent entry to join India's wealthiest women with a net worth of ₹13,380 crore. The 37-year-old Indian-American grew up in Pune, and studied Computer Science at the Georgia Institute of Technology. The youngest woman entrepreneur boasts of a illustrious career, as before launching Confluent, Neha Narkhede had worked with LinkedIn. In July, she had bagged the 8th position among the top 10 richest Indian women.

MARK ZUCKERBERG'S \$71 BILLION WEALTH WIPEOUT

Mark Zuckerberg's foray into the metaverse has cost him heavily. Even in a difficult year for nearly every US tech titan, the wealth wiped out from Meta Platforms Inc. stands out. His fortune has been slashed in half and then some, with a

\$71 billion reduction so far this year, the largest among the ultra-rich tracked by the Bloomberg Billionaires Index. His net worth of \$55.9 billion places him 20th among global billionaires, his lowest position since 2014. It was less than two years ago that Zuckerberg, 38, was worth \$106 billion and was part of an elite group of global billionaires that included only Jeff Bezos and Bill Gates.

Tech giant Microsoft has announced that it is now rolling out the latest version of Windows 11 -- Windows 11 2022 update -- in more than 190 countries. The company said the new update will expand Amazon App Store Preview to international markets, built-in Game Pass for

Windows 11, new accessibility features, advanced security updates, and much more. Eligible users can choose to install the new update by opening Windows Update settings and selecting Check for updates. It is also announcing a new set of experiences including the Tabbed File explorer, considered a component of the 2022 Update for all editions, which will be ready this October.

CLASS 10 PUNE BOY SELECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN NASA-LED COMPETITION

Sonit Sisolekar, a 15-year-old Class 10 student in Pune has been selected to participate in the Great Lunar Expedition for Everyone (GLEE) 2023, a NASA-led competition. He's a recipient of the Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya

Bal Puraskar of 2021. GLEE is NASA's mission to the lunar surface for school students around the world. It aims to send small satellites called Lunasats, weighing 5 grams, to conduct scientific and technology testing on the lunar surface.

DELHI TO REMOVE MASK FINE FROM 1ST OCTOBER



The Delhi Disaster Management Authority has decided to stop fining people ₹500 for not wearing masks in public places from October 1 as COVID-19 cases in the city have declined steadily. On March 31,

DDMA had decided not to levy fines for not wearing face masks in public places, but it reimposed the penalty within three weeks after an uptick in test positivity rate and increase in daily cases of Covid-19.

THE WORLD'S HIGHEST BATTLEFIELD SIACHEN GLACIER GETS SATELLITE-BASED INTERNET SERVICE



The Indian Army has achieved a remarkable feat by activating satellite-based broadband service at the highest battlefield in the world, the Siachen glacier, located in the eastern Karakoram range of the Himalayas. The Siachen Glacier, at a height of around 20,000 feet is known as the highest militarized zone in the world where the soldiers have to battle extreme weather.

MINI IPL 2023 AUCTION ON 16TH DECEMBER

A one-day mini-auction for IPL 2023 is reportedly set to take place on December 16. Franchises are said to have a purse of 95 crores for the mini-auction with November end being the deadline for retained and released players' list from each team. Meanwhile, Delhi Capitals have reportedly approached CSK with a trade request for all-rounder Ravindra Jadeja.



NIZAM'S SERPENT-SWORD TO RETURN FROM UK



GOVERNMENT PROPOSES LAW TO ACCESS ENCRYPTED MESSAGES


The government of India has proposed a new law that would intercept encrypted messages on instant messaging apps like WhatsApp and Signal. When users flock to a new app in 2022, the first thing they check for is end-to-end encryption. This feature blocks anyone except the sender and receiver from reading the conversation. WhatsApp claims it only has access to a few messages if a report is registered. Otherwise, nobody can access and read the chats.

on the back, went for the highest amount of any game-worn sports memorabilia ever.

BILLIONAIRE BUSINESSMAN CHIP WILSON DONATES \$76 MN TO PRESERVE CANADA'S FOREST LAND

Billionaire businessman and Founder of Lululemon Athletica, Chip Wilson, has decided to donate C\$100 million (\$75.8 million) to preserve wilderness in Canada. The donation will be used to purchase forests in British Columbia along with mining, forestry and other resource licenses to turn the lands into parks that indigenous groups can manage and profit from through tourism.



SAUDI ARABIA TO SEND WOMAN ASTRONAUT INTO SPACE



Saudi Arabia has said that it will start training programme with the aim to send a woman astronaut into space by next year. The programme will be part of the kingdom's Vision 2030 plan. The first Arab to go to space was Saudi Arabian Prince Sultan bin Salman in 1985 as part of a NASA mission.

JAPAN TO LIFT RESTRICTIONS ON FOREIGN TOURISTS

Japan will open its doors back up to vaccinated foreign tourists, after more than two years of closed borders due to the Covid pandemic. Tourists will be able to visit the country without a visa, and will no longer need to go through a travel agency, from 11 October. A cap on daily arrivals will also be lifted. Visitors will still need to prove their triple vaccination status and submit a negative Covid test result to enter.



APPLE MAY UNVEIL IPHONE 15 ULTRA NEXT YEAR



Tech giant Apple may rename the Pro Max lineup with Ultra that will arrive with 8K video and better battery life in 2023. The iPhone 15 Ultra will have some exclusive hardware. 8K video recording is one possibility, though it is also possible that the iPhone 15 Pro will support it as well. The Ultra will exclusively have a periscope lens (6x or 5x). Also, the Ultra will have

improved battery life and last 3-4 hours longer. The iPhone 15 Ultra is expected to go up in price compared to the 14 Pro Max, possibly starting at \$1,200 (up from \$1,100).

of the company. To begin with, the "S" stands for the initial of the company's name. Also, it forms a location symbol, thus creating a link with the company's offer.



Now, lifelike robots are becoming more and more popular in the real world, with many able to produce human speech and facial expressions with eerie precision.



WHICH IS THE WORLD'S MOST ADVANCED HUMANOID ROBOT?

Ameca, the 'world's most advanced' humanoid robot can perform a range of facial expressions including winking, pursing its lips and scrunching its nose – just like a real person.

SOPHIA - THE FIRST ROBOT TO BE GRANTED LEGAL CITIZENSHIP

Sophia first emerged in 2016 as a super-intelligent human-like head with a realistic face. The humanoid robot, created by Hong Kong firm Hanson robotics, can chat, smile mischievously and even tell jokes. The robot made history in October 2017 when she became legal a citizen of Saudi Arabia.




CYBERONE - THE FACELESS HUMANOID

CyberOne is fitted with an AI interaction algorithm that allows it to perceive 3D space, as well as recognise individuals, gestures, and expressions from humans.



Japanese scientists have developed a robot child, which they hope will make it easier for dentists to manage encounters with nervous patients.

In terms of face and head functions, the bot can change in facial colour and roll its eyes back in its head.



NIKOLA - THE EMOTIONAL CHILD BOT

Japan has revealed a robot child called Nikola, which can convey six basic emotions. The android has moving 'muscles' in its face that allow it to convey happiness, sadness, fear, anger, surprise and disgust.



COULD YOUR FACE BE NEXT?

Promobot is seeking a face for its next humanoid robot, which will be used in hotels, shopping malls and airports from 2023. The firm is offering a whopping £150,000 (\$200,000) to the brave volunteer, who must be willing to transfer the rights to use of their face forever.

SCIENCE & ENVIRONMENT

SCIENTISTS CREATE WORLD'S FIRST CLONED WILD ARCTIC WOLF



Scientists in China have created the world's first cloned wild Arctic wolf 'Maya'. The successful cloning of the species which is native to the High Arctic tundra of Canada's Queen Elizabeth Islands, is considered a milestone achievement in conserving rare and endangered species through technology. Cloning, the process

of creating copies of living organisms, including cells, tissues, etc, was first used to create an animal in 1996 by a Scottish scientist.

THE WORLD'S OLDEST HEART FOUND IN 380-MILLION-YEAR-OLD FISH IN AUSTRALIA

Researchers from Australia's Curtin University have discovered a 380-million-year-old heart preserved inside a fossilised prehistoric fish, claiming it to be the world's oldest heart. The researchers



also found fossilised stomach, intestine and liver in the ancient jawed fish. The discovery is remarkable as the fish's soft tissues were rarely preserved, said lead researcher Professor Kate Trinajstić.

LONGEST PARTIAL ECLIPSE OF CENTURY TO OCCUR ON 19 NOVEMBER



This year, the longest partial lunar eclipse in 580 years will take place overnight on 18-19 November, as per NASA. The eclipse will be visible in all parts of the US and parts of Australia, East Asia and South America as well. The eclipse will last for about 3 hours 28 minutes and 23 seconds. In India, the eclipse

will be visible from some areas of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh for a short while. The eclipse in India will last from 12:48 pm to 4:17 pm.

JUPITER SET TO MAKE CLOSEST APPROACH TO EARTH IN 59 YEARS

Jupiter will make its closest approach to Earth in about last six decades, next week. On 26 September, it will also reach 'opposition', a phenomenon that, from the viewpoint of Earth's surface, happens when an astronomical object rises in the east as the Sun sets in the west, placing the object and the Sun on opposite sides of Earth. Jupiter is approximately 960 million km away from Earth at its farthest point.

TECHNOLOGY

FLYING BIKE THAT TRAVELS 100KMS FOR UP TO 40 MINUTES

A hoverbike that travels at 100kms for up to 40 minutes made its US debut at the North American Auto Show recently. The flying craft has been in development for two years from Delaware-based Aerwins and currently costs a whopping \$777,000.

The hoverbike is the work of Aerwins, a Delaware-based company that makes drones and unmanned vehicles. The hoverbike has been on sale in Japan - which does not classify it as an aircraft and therefore doesn't require a license to pilot it.



GAME-CHANGING NEW BATTERY FOR ELECTRIC CARS



A game-changing new battery for electric vehicles (EVs) that charges in three minutes and lasts for 20 years could soon be coming to new cars. Adden Energy, a start-up based in Waltham, Massachusetts, has been granted a licence to build

the battery design at scale to fit in EVs. The battery, developed by Harvard scientists, is lithium metal, rather than lithium ion found in EVs that are already on the market.

SCIENTISTS DEVELOP LAUGHTER MODEL TO MAKE ROBOTS MORE HUMAN



Scientists at Japan's Kyoto University have developed a model of shared laughter to make robots more human. Scientists incorporated the model into Android Erica, a humanlike robot, to help it choose between solo laughs, social laughs and gleeful laughter. This study is a pivotal step towards

adding humanness to robots. Laughter is a very privileged and complex human emotion.



INDIAN BADMINTON DUO DHRUV-ARJUN WIN THEIR 1ST INTERNATIONAL TITLE



The world Championships quarterfinalists Dhruv Kapila and MR Arjun have registered victories to clinch the men's doubles title at the Maharashtra International Challenge badminton tournament in Nagpur on 18th September. The Indian pair defeated Thailand's badminton pair of Chaloepon Charoenkitamorn and Nanthakarn Yordphaisong. Notably, this was the pair's first international title.

ENGLAND ANNOUNCE SCHEDULE FOR ASHES 2023



England has announced the schedule for Ashes 2023 that will be held between June 16 to July 31, with Edgbaston, Lord's, Headingley, Old Trafford and The Oval set to host the Tests, the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB) announced. The first Test will begin on June 16 at Edgbaston, while the last Test will take place at The Oval starting July 27.

ARSENAL'S ETHAN NWANERI BECOMES PREMIER LEAGUE'S YOUNGEST-EVER PLAYER AT 15



Arsenal midfielder Ethan Nwaneri has created history by becoming the youngest-ever player to feature in a Premier League match. Aged 15 years, 5 months and 23 days, Nwaneri has made several appearances for Arsenal Under-18s and played for England Under-16s when he was 14. He has broken the record previously held by Liverpool's Harvey Elliott (16 years, 30 days). Elliott set the then record in 2019.

TEAM INDIA'S NEW JERSEY LAUNCHED AHEAD OF T20 WORLD CUP 2022



Team India's new T20I kit called 'One Blue Jersey' has been launched ahead of T20 World Cup 2022. The new jersey has a lighter shade of blue. The jersey was launched by BCCI and Team India's official kit sponsor, MPL Sports, at an event in Mumbai. Team India is expected to wear the jersey starting with T20I series against Australia.

ANAHAT SINGH THE YOUNGEST ATHLETE TO REPRESENT INDIA



Anahat Singh is an Indian squash player. At the age of 14, she is the youngest athlete to represent India. She rose to prominence after winning the Girls U11 title at the British Junior Open Squash in January 2019, followed by the Girls U13 title at the Dutch Junior Open Squash in July the same year. In June 2022, Singh won the Girls U15 title of the Asian Junior Squash Individual Championships. As of June 2022, she is the top ranked player in Asia in the

Girls U15 category. She was also a part of the 2021-22 PSA World Tour, by virtue of reaching quarterfinals of the HCL SRFI Indian Tour - Noida held during 4-7 September 2021.




