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## XI JINPING ALL SET FOR A RARE THIRD TERM IN POWER

China's all-powerful President Xi Jinping turned 69 as he is all set to continue in power for an unprecedented third term, defying the 68-year retirement age rule followed by his predecessors. The decision would further tighten his grip on China. It is possible that Mr Xi, 69, will remain in power for the rest of his life. He is also referred to as Paramount or Supreme leader. Mr Xi is likely to retain the first two titles, party General Secretary and Central Military Commission chairman at the party congress - which takes place every five years - and the presidency at the annual National People's Congress in Spring 2023. Mr Xi leads the world's second-largest economy and one of its biggest military forces. Some analysts say he is likely to push China towards a more authoritarian political stance in a third five-year term.



## MARK ZUCKERBERG LOSES OVER 119 MILLION FACEBOOK FOLLOWERS

Meta founder and CEO Mark Zuckerberg has lost over 119 million followers which has brought down his follower count to below 10,000. Several users of Meta's Facebook are complaining losing majority of their followers on the social

media platform due to unknown reasons. The social media platform has acknowledged this issue and reported that it is working on it to fix the follower count of those who witnessed a big drop.

## HARRY POTTER-THEMED COINS RELEASED IN UK



The Royal Mint, which makes all the coins in the United Kingdom, has released Harry Potter-themed 50p coins to celebrate 25th anniversary of the publication of 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone' by JK Rowling in 1997. The book was published by Bloomsbury Publishing and was the first in

the series of stories detailing Harry Potter's life at the wizard school Hogwarts. The special Harry Potter-themed coins will feature not just Harry's face, but will also have portraits of Queen Elizabeth II and the recently proclaimed King Charles III on it.

## UK PRIME MINISTER LIZ TRUSS RESIGNS AFTER 45 DAYS IN OFFICE



Liz Truss

Liz Truss has resigned as UK Prime Minister after 45 days in office amid massive economic crisis, becoming the shortest-serving leader in British history. Conservatives will choose a new UK leader within a week,

Truss said in her resignation statement. She had defeated Indian-origin Rishi Sunak in the UK PM race.

## NO TEXTBOOKS TILL AGE 6 IN NEW SYLLABUS PLAN



The government has launched a new foundational curriculum framework for children. There would be no textbooks for children between ages three and six. Learning would be based on toys, play and lived experience, use of mother tongue, stories of Indian heroes and traditional concepts of teaching, books

incorporating diversity, gender, moral and ethical awareness, and assessment through observation and analyzing creativity.

### DELHI GOVERNMENT BANS BURSTING OF FIRECRACKERS




Delhi government has banned the bursting of firecrackers on Diwali. Bof crackers can attract a jail term of up to six months and a fine of Rs 200. The government also said that the production, storage, and sale of crackers in Delhi will

be punishable with a fine of up to Rs 5,000 and three years in jail under Section 9B of the Explosives Act.

### INSTAGRAM INTRODUCES AI-POWERED AGE VERIFICATION PROCESS IN INDIA

Instagram has announced that it is expanding the testing options for its AI-powered age verification feature to India and Brazil. The feature will allow users to upload a video of themselves, which Instagram runs through an AI system to determine whether the user is aged 18 or older. Meta has partnered with Yoti that specialises in AI-based online age verification.



### ALL NEW NATIONAL HIGHWAYS TO HAVE HELIPADS



The government is looking at having helipads along new highways as that will help in immediate evacuations during emergencies. The helicopter will be based at the hospital at 20 minute notice and will have a

service cover to an area of 150 km radius. Currently, there are around 80 dedicated helicopter corridors.

### 75 INDIAN INSTITUTIONS FEATURE IN WORLD UNIVERSITY RANKINGS 2023

Around 75 Indian higher education institutions have featured in the Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2023. This is higher compared to 56 Indian institutions in 2020 and only 31 in 2017. Seven Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) have made it this time around. These are IIT Ropar, IIT Indore, IIT Gandhinagar, IIT Patna, IIT Bhubhaneswar, IIT Guwahati and IIT Mandi.

tournament. The top three purchasing countries are Qatar, the United States and Saudi Arabia.

### SEALED IPHONE FROM 2007 SELLS FOR OVER 60 TIMES ITS ORIGINAL PRICE

An unopened first-generation iPhone from 2007 was auctioned for \$39,339.60 by US-based LCG Auctions. When it was first released, the phone was priced at \$499 to \$599 and has now fetched over 60 times that price at the auction. The unused 8GB iPhone came with a 3.5-inch screen, a 2-megapixel camera, and a web browser.



### AUSTRALIA REVERSES DECISION TO RECOGNIZE WEST JERUSALEM AS ISRAELI CAPITAL



Australia has reversed a decision made four years ago to recognize West Jerusalem as the capital of Israel. Canberra's decision in 2018 had undermined peace and put Australia out of step with other nations. The status of Jerusalem is one of the most contested issues between Israel and the Palestinians. Israel's foreign

ministry has expressed its deep disappointment at Australia's decision and will summon its Ambassador.

### SRI LANKAN AUTHOR SHEHAN KARUNATILAKA WINS £50,000 BOOKER PRIZE

Sri Lankan author Shehan Karunatilaka has won the 2022 Booker Prize for Fiction for his novel 'The Seven Moons of Maali Almeida'. The book centers around the killing of a war photographer in Colombo in the 1990s and explores life after death amid a Sri Lanka beset by civil war. Karunatilaka bagged a prize money of £50,000.

## DEEP IN THE SEA




The ocean is deep. It is made up of 4 different zones, or areas.

### WHAT IS THE SUNLIGHT ZONE?

- The sunlight zone is also considered to be the hottest level.

## NASA'S DRAGONFLY TO LAND ON DUNES & SHATTERED ICE ON SATURN'S MOON




NASA's Dragonfly rotorcraft is scheduled to land on the Selk Crater region of Saturn's moon Titan in 2034. The region is a patchwork of sand dunes and broken-up ice. Dragonfly will land in an equatorial, dry region of Titan, a frigid, thick-

atmosphere, hydrocarbon world. It rains liquid methane sometimes, but it's more like a desert on Earth.

## NASA TO LAUNCH A HUGE FLYING SAUCER

NASA is set to launch the Inflatable Decelerator (LOFTID) prototype into space next month. The aim is to demonstrate how the inflatable heat shield design can slow down a spacecraft to survive atmospheric entry. This technology could support landing crew and large robotic missions on Mars, as well as returning heavier payloads to Earth.

## THE MOBILITY-ENHANCING EXOSKELETON BOOT



An exoskeleton boot that enables the wearer to walk 9% faster than with normal shoes, and with 17% less effort, has been revealed by scientists at Stanford University. The robotic footwear comes with a motor that works with calf muscles to give the wearer an extra push with every step. The precisely-timed motor controls the boot so that it imparts a 'torque' – a twisting force that can cause rotation around an axis – at the leg joint.

## OVER 30,000 NEAR-EARTH ASTEROIDS HAVE BEEN DISCOVERED SO FAR

According to the European Space Agency (ESA), over 30,000 near-Earth Asteroids (NEAs) have been discovered so far. NEAs are rocky bodies orbiting the Sun on a path that brings them close to Earth's orbit. They comprise one-third of around one million asteroids discovered in the solar system. Most of these NEAs live in the asteroid belt between Jupiter and Mars.

## THE ELECTRIC WATER BIKE

An incredible new electric bike has been unveiled that can be ridden on water at 20 kph and retails for around \$9,000. The Hydrofoiler SL3 comes from New Zealand-based company Manta5, the creators of the world's first hydrofoil bike, the Hydrofoiler XE-1, back in 2017. Described as 'half bike, half plane', the Hydrofoiler bikes work by the rider pedalling to spin a propeller on the back, which is augmented by an electric motor to help gain speed.



## APPLE'S SUPERCHARGED NEW IPAD PRO



Apple has officially launched its new, M2 supercharged iPad Pro that swaps the home button for a fingerprint reader and pairs with a next-level Apple Pencil. The two tablets, an 11- and 12.9-inch are up to 15 percent faster than the 2021 model thanks to the new chip that was first featured in the latest MacBook Air. The iPad Pro also delivers up to 35 percent faster graphics performance and includes a 16-core Neural Engine that can process 15.8 trillion operations per second, helping it keep up 'with the most demanding workflow.'

## THE WORLD'S FIRST ALL-ELECTRIC PASSENGER PLANE



Alice, the world's first all-electric passenger plane took to the skies for the first time to reach an altitude of 3,500 feet during an 8-minute flight in Washington. The zero emissions plane is the brainchild of U.S.-based Eviation and it's set for regional passenger and cargo uses. Alice is powered by two 640-kilowatt electric motors and produces significantly less noise than a traditional airplane.

## APPLE'S MIXED REALITY HEADSET TO SCAN EYES FOR PAYMENTS

Apple's rumored virtual and augmented reality headset will reportedly have the ability to scan eyes to allow users to sign into their accounts and make payments. The feature will make it easier for multiple people to use the same device. The headset will also have downward-facing cameras to capture the leg movement of users.







## THE YOUNGEST CRICKETER TO PLAY IN T20 WORLD CUP HISTORY



UAE all-rounder Ayan Afzal Khan has become the youngest-ever cricketer to feature in a men's T20 World Cup match, achieving the feat during his team's match against Netherlands in Geelong. Ayan set the record at the age of 16 years and 335 days. The previous record was held by Pakistan fast bowler Mohammad Amir (17 years and 55 days).

## PAT CUMMINS BECOMES AUSTRALIA'S NEW ODI CAPTAIN



Pat Cummins has been appointed Australia's new ODI captain. The 29-year-old replaces Aaron Finch, who retired from ODI cricket last month. Cricket Australia said that David Warner was not able to be considered for the job as his lifetime leadership ban remains in place. Cummins will be Australia's 27th ODI captain.

## SIKANDAR RAZA SMASHES HIGHEST-EVER SCORE BY A ZIMBABWE BATTER IN T20 WORLD CUP HISTORY



Zimbabwe middle-order batter Sikandar Raza has created history by smashing the highest-ever score by a Zimbabwe batter in the history of T20 World Cup. The 36-year-old scored 82(48) against Ireland to set the record. The previous record was held by Brendan Taylor, who had smashed 60\*(45) against Australia in T20 World Cup 2007.

## 16-YEAR-OLD INDIAN GRANDMASTER GUKESH D BECOMES THE YOUNGEST TO BEAT WORLD CHAMPION CARLSEN



India's 16-year-old Grandmaster Gukesh D has created history by becoming the youngest chess player to beat Magnus Carlsen after he became the world champion. Gukesh achieved the feat by defeating the world number one in the ninth round of Aimchess Rapid. Earlier in the tournament, India's 19-year-old Grandmaster Arjun Erigaisi had defeated Carlsen.

## MICHAEL GERARD TYSON THE BADDEST MAN ON THE PLANET



Michael Gerard Tyson is an American former professional boxer who competed from 1985 to 2005. Nicknamed "Iron Mike" and "Kid Dynamite" in his early career, and later known as "The Baddest Man on the Planet", Tyson is considered to be one of the greatest heavyweight boxers of all time. He reigned as the undisputed world heavyweight champion from 1987 to 1990. Tyson won his first 19 professional fights by knockout, 12 of them in the first round. Claiming his first belt at 20 years, four months,

and 22 days old, Tyson holds the record as the youngest boxer ever to win a heavyweight title. He was the first heavyweight boxer to simultaneously hold the WBA, WBC and IBF titles, as well as the only heavyweight to unify them in succession. The following year, Tyson became the lineal champion when he knocked out Michael Spinks in 91 seconds of the first round. In 1990, Tyson was knocked out by underdog Buster Douglas in one of the biggest upsets in history.


